



The Gender Pay Gap - ICELAND

The unadjusted gender pay gap 2008–2017




Key figures:

- Average annual income from work in 2017 for women with tertiary education (postsecondary education) was **72% of men's income** on the same education level or 6.7 million ISK compared with 9.3 million ISK. (64% for “Upper second. Ed.” & 68% for “basic ed.”)
- In 2018, the labour force participation rate was 78% for women and 85% for men.
