






SPQ Infrastructure




Stages to create the **Tecnhical Committee**

October 2019	Translation of Icelandic standard (ST 85:2012 (EN to PT)
October - November 2019	Identify Stakeholders - entities for the constitution of the Portuguese Technical Committee: SMEs, Industry and Commerce, Universities and Technological Centers, Public Administration, Regulatory Authorities, Certifiers, NGOs, Trade Unions, consumer representative bodies, experts, (Participant Categories - about 20 entities)
November 2019 (10 dec.)	Invite stakeholders/entities to integrate the Portuguese Technical Committee
December 2019 – February 2020	Establish (make official) the Portuguese Technical Committee
March 2020	1.st Meeting of the Portuguese Technical Committee (TC)
January 2020 - May 2022	 IPQ provides the methology, documentation, tools to support the activities of the TC: RPNP, Principles, Codes of Conduct, Welcome Manual, Good Practices to promote meeting effectiveness, Working Rules, Guides, Vocabularies, Trainning and provides many models for a practical/operational management TC's activity IPQ coordinates and follows closely the work of the TC until the edition and publication of Portuguese Standard in May 2022



Stages to develop the Portuguese Standard

March 2020	1.st Meeting of the Portuguese Technical Committee (TC) and definition of work's methodologies Translation of Icelandic standard ÍST 85:2012 (EN to PT) is finished
March 2020 - September 2021 (aNP)	. Portuguese TC meetings to build the "Equal Wage Standard Management System", according to the Deming cycle (methodology PDCA) Preliminary draft (PD) and Committee draft) (CD) . Portuguese TC approves by consensus the CD and sends to IPQ
October - December 2021 (prNP)	 IPQ verifies/checks: Normative Consistency with the Rules and Procedures of Portuguese Standardization Public Inquiry Procedure
	. After approval of IPQ, the normative document becames a Standard Project and IPQ does editorial formatting ($receives\ a\ n.^{o}$)
	. Portugal notifies CEN - European Committee for Standardization (iProjex)
15 January - 15 February 2022	National Public Inquiry/Consultation (30 days)
16 February - 15 April 2022	. During the Inquiry stage IPQ receives public comments about the projet standard and sends to portuguese TC to evaluate
	. TC appreciates the comments made by society, answers who commented and decides on their integration, by consensus
	. TC sends the <i>Final Project</i> of the standard to IPQ
16 April - 14 May 2022 (NP)	 IPQ verifies/checks: Normative Consistency with the Rules and Procedures of Portuguese Standardization Procedure of homologation/ratification and edition
	. IPQ does editorial formatting and the normative document becames a <i>Portuguese Standard</i> . Production of a Fact Sheet
15 May 2022	Edition of the Portuguese Standard "Equal Wage Standard Management System"

- ✓ The big challenge for the Vowels and the participating entities is the time and money that they invest in standardization's activity
- ✓ By ensuring that activities by this methodology are planned and scheduled, and that available resources are continuously monitored and adjusted, will be easier for Vowels to plan their participation in the TC

Project Equality Platform and Standard

Why Portugal/IPQ is interested in the development and implementation of this Standard?

- > Promote Social justice (combat gender-based wage descrimination)
- Lead us to a redution of unfounded pay gaps (inequalities)
- Helps having a transparent remuneration policy
- Government public policies (3 in row)
- > Portugal signed the UNECE Declaration and is implementing a "Gender Action Plan";
- > SDG's
- A "Management System" means to involve top management and the entire hierarchical chain; make clear the processes and procedures about the payment criteria, career progression, equal opportunities; promotes a more efficient division of labour, can reduce costs,...

The "Equal Wage Management System" can be integrated into other Management Systems!

Mandatory Adoption?!


To make the standard mandatory ... we have to highlight the real impacts on the economy and articulate with the Government

We can learn from icelandic experience (now are reviewing ÍST 85:2012)!



Some items for adaptation/reflection:

- What is the sphere of action private, public, both?
 (in PT the wages of public workers are tabulated)
- Difficulties in the practical application of mandatory procedures? (Legal and others requirements (4.3.2), Communication (4.4.3), Control of documents (4.4.5), Monitoring and measurement (4.5.1), Assessment of compliance (4.5.2), Control of records (4.5.4), Nonconformities, corrective and preventive actions (4.5.3), Internal Audit (4.5.5),...
- In PT the Gender Pay Gap is 16 % (potential "resistants" reactions of all parties involved, ex.: trade unions, employers's representatives,...)
- Obstacles that we will may have to overcome
- Advices related to the informative Annexes:
 - B Guidelines on the classification of jobs
 - C Guidelines on the preparation of wage analyses
 - D Judgments and decisions
